Homework

Thank you to everyone who completed the homework questionnaire at the end of last term. We have consulted with parent views and also other local schools to make decisions on our homework policy and expectation going forward. Home work expectations will include regular reading at home, timetable practice on times table rockstars, and 6 optional homework tasks linking to the children's wider learning in school. There will no longer be a weekly maths and English homework sent home in key stage 2 or weekly

spellings. Your child will be assessed on the spelling they are expected to be able to spell at the end of their year group 'common exception words'. This list will be sent home so as you know which spellings they needs to practice throughput the year. The children will be retested on these words 3 time per year (once per full term) and an updated list will be sent home. Any year group specific guidance on homework expectations will be shared with you at the meet the teacher events next week.

Maths and Phonics Parent Information Workshops

We would like to invite parents to attend some information workshops early this term to have a better understanding of how Maths and phonics are taught in school and give you ideas for how you can help at home. These workshops will take place straight after school and we will arrange for school age children to be supervised whilst you attend.




