This final newsletter is to provide some important information for September so have your diaries and calendars at the ready.

We have 2 TD days at the start of term on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September and we will welcome the children back to school for their first day on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September.

The second week of term (9<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> September) will be parent welcome meetings. This is a chance for parents to visit classrooms and for teaching teams to formally introduce themselves and talk about the year ahead. We encourage you to come along to these meetings where you will also have the opportunity to ask any questions.

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September – Bumblebee Class (Year R/1) 3:30 – 4:00pm

Individual School photographs will be on: Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> and Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2024. All children will need to wear school uniform on these days and if this falls on a PE day they may bring trainers in their bag to change into for their PE session. Days for PE will be sent home at the end of the first week back in September.

Next year we will be changing the dates of the two parents' evenings to align with our data drops. This will enable teachers to share the academic progress of your children at both meetings. These will take place in January and April with end of year reports being sent home in July.

In October we will host an open afternoon for you to be able to visit your child's classroom and share their work from the first term with them. Teaching staff will be available for you to ask any questions or arrange a more formal meeting if you have any worries or concerns about how your child is settling in their new class. The date for the open classrooms' afternoon is Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2024 and will run from 3:30 – 5pm

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> January 3:30pm – 5:30pm

Further dates for the year ahead will be sent out in September once the diary has been finalised.
