

Mathematics

Year 3 - This term we will be focusing on multiplication and division. Firstly, we will be looking at times-tables reinforcing aspects we have already been focusing on since September. We will also look at using the column method for multiplication. Year 3 will then move on to learning about length and perimeter.

Year 4 - Will be looking at multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 focusing on what patterns we can see when doing this. Towards the end of term year 4 will also move onto length and perimeter.

Music

During our music lessons this term, we will be exploring many different styles of music. We will be using glockenspiels to create some of our own music.

Computing

The children will be working on developing their computer programming skills, using the online programming website 'Scratch'.

P.E.

The children will be focusing on dynamic balances and ball skills during their real PE sessions. We will also be using real dance to create different shapes and balances solo and partnering lifts to music.

Art/DT

In DT children will be focusing on textiles. They will analyse and evaluate a range of existing fastenings, then devise a list of design criteria to design, generate templates and make a fabric book sleeve. In art, children will be focusing on graphic design, in particular typography. Children will be researching WW2 propaganda posters and looking closely at their typefaces before designing their own poster.

Geography

Children will be using map skills to locate where the war took place and the countries involved.

History

As part of our big question, we will research many aspects of WW2 including: why Britain went to war, the reasons it was necessary for children to be evacuated, how Britain fought, how civilians continue normal life during the war, the home front and how/why VE day was celebrated.

R.E. & P.S.H.E.

This term, the children will be looking at the question 'How can we make Wiltshire and my town a more respectful place?' in R.E.

In P.S.H.E., the children will explore the topic of 'Dreams and Goals'. They will be looking at how the world can support them in their dreams and go

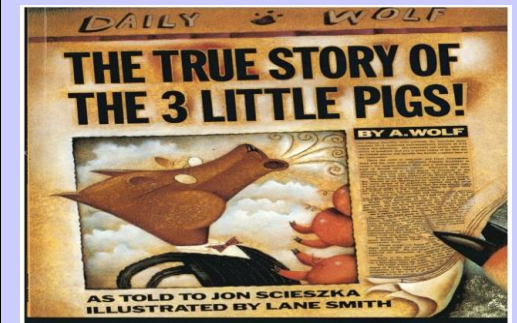
Science

This term Leopards will be focusing on the unit Light. They will explore different light sources as well as focus specifically on the sun. Leopards will focus on how we are able to see and shadows also what is opaque, translucent and transparent. We will also be planning, investigating and evaluating a shadow experiment.

English

For this term using write stuff Leopards will be focusing on a narrative text type based on the book 'The True Story of Three Little Pigs' by Jon Scieszka. This story is based on the classic Three little pigs but from the Wolf's perspective. Each lesson will be based around a plot point and split into chunks. We will create rich ideas together, leading to children creating their own paragraphs each lesson. By the end of the unit children will produce a longer independent write based on this story.

Children will also have opportunities to read with adults each week and reading time for pleasure.



French

In French, the children will focus on the topic of shapes. Learning how to say different shapes in French whilst practicing what they have already learnt in previous terms.
