

Mathematics

Year 3 – Children will carry on with adding and subtracting up to 3-digit numbers starting to look at the column method and exchanging. They will then move onto multiplication and division, focusing on arrays and the 2, 5, 10- and 3-times tables.

Year 4 – Children will begin the term finishing adding and subtracting numbers to 4 digits. They will then move on to measuring area. Towards the end of term, they will start to focus on multiplication and division.

Music

This term, we will be leaning to play the glockenspiel which will then be looked at in more detail after Christmas. Children will also be focusing on Christmas carols throughout the term in preparation for our concert.

Art

This term Leopards will be focusing on mountainscapes. They will begin by exploring a different range of painting techniques of watercolour, poster paints and acrylic before using acrylics to create their own mountainscape.

Computing

This term Leopards will be using the programme scratch to create animations and look at loops.

DT

This term Leopards will be introduced to various forms of 'Information design' before they are briefed to develop an electric museum display based on The World.

Science

This term year 3/4 will be focusing on nutrition and diet looking at food groups and what makes a balanced diet. We will also be comparing different diets and looking at diets that other animals have. We will also think about food waste and how we can reduce food waste at home and in school.

English

In English this term Leopards will be looking at the poem 'I Asked the Little Boy Who Cannot See'. After creating a class poem together, they will then independently write their own poem. Towards the end of term using the write stuff we will look at advertisements. Children will then be asked to create an advertisement that could be used on social media for a food product or toy related to Christmas.

Throughout the term, the children will continue to read with adults regularly, be read to each day from our class books, and enjoy daily 'Reading for Pleasure' time.

Geography

Children will be using maps, atlases and globes to locate the world's continents and countries with a focus on Europe (including the location of Russia) and North and South America. Children will concentrate on the continent's environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries and major cities.

R.E. & P.S.H.E.

This term in R.E., we will be looking at the question 'What are the deeper meanings of festivals?' focusing specifically on Christianity.

In P.S.H.E., the children will explore the topic of 'Celebrating Difference', looking at judging by appearances, how we look, understanding influences and understanding bullying. They will celebrate their own differences and uniqueness.

P.E.

This term in real PE we will focus on jumping and landing skills. We will also focus on real gym creating routines involving balance and flight. The first two weeks of term we also have an outside coach teaching us some cricket skills.

French

In French, the children will focus on the topic of 'En Famille' (Family). They will learn how to talk about their families, using the nouns and definite articles for family members, and the possessives 'mon', 'ma', and 'mes'.
