### Research

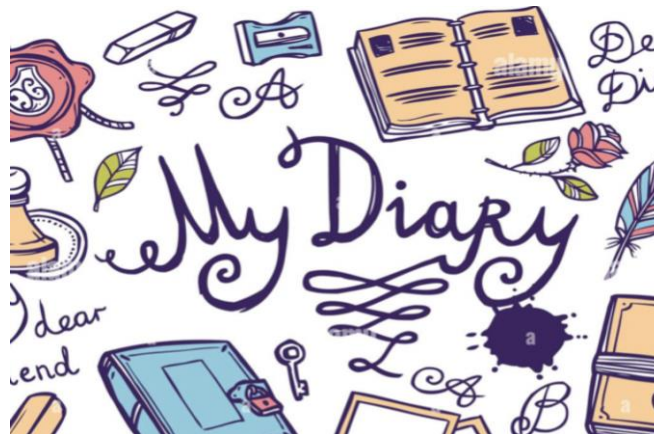
